CAMP CONNOLLY

Campers will enjoy a wide range of activities each week including:

Sports – Recreational Swimming – Weekly Special Events – Adventure Games – Swim Lessons

Scouts – Ages 3-6

Monday – Friday, 9:00am-5:00pm

This unique camp experience will support your child's skills and foster their appreciation for art, music, water safety, and sports. Weekly theme-related activities will enhance individual creative expression. Children will grow and become more self-assured through group times, sports, social interaction, outdoor play, and swim. Children will have fun meeting new friends in a great activity-filled environment. Children must be potty trained to attend this program. Swimming is offered each day with progressive lessons two times per week.

Voyagers – Ages 7-12

Monday – Friday, 9:00am – 5:00pm

Get ready for a fun-filled camp experience packed with exciting activities, weekly special events, and countless opportunities for your child to build friendships and memories that will last a lifetime. Each week our campers and staff will participate in theme-related games and arts & crafts projects, and they will finish the week with a special event or entertainer. Swimming is offered twice each day with progressive lessons two times per week.

TEEN LEADERSHIP PROGRAMS

Leaders in Training (LIT) Ages 13 –14

NEW 2-Week Sessions

Monday – Friday, 9:00am – 5:00pm

The YMCA's Leaders in Training Program (LIT) is a two-week instructional program designed to mentor future camp counselors. In addition to actively assisting our camp staff, LITs will spend time as a group taking part in all camp activities while interacting with our younger campers. Throughout this two-week program, LITs will participate in service-learning projects in the community and leadership development training at our branch.

Junior Counselor Program

Ages 15+

Monday – Friday, 9:00am – 5:00pm

This volunteer leadership opportunity provides participants with valuable hands-on experience as counselors under the guidance of our staff. Junior counselors are required to complete a volunteer application (available at the Welcome Center) and commit to a minimum of two full weeks of participation. Enrollment in this program requires an interview with Camp Connolly leadership staff.

TEAM CONNOLLY SPORTS CAMPS

Our sports camps are open to children 7-12 years old of all ability levels. Along with daily instruction, scrimmages, and games, your child will learn the importance of teamwork and the benefits of healthy activity and competition. Campers will also enjoy daily free-swim time, non-sport camp games, and special events throughout the week. All camps run Monday through Friday, 9am-5pm, with an option for Pre- and Post-Camp Extended Care available.

Sports Mania

Week 1: June 25-29

*Week 2 is only 4 days due to 4th of July holiday and the cost for this week is prorated.

This camp focuses on a variety of sports and games including soccer, football, floor hockey, dodgeball, basketball and more. Children will learn the basic rules and strategy of each sport while playing in daily mini-games. Healthy competition will be a part of this camp program—teaching children sportsmanship and teamwork.

Basketball Camp

Week 4: July 16-20

Week 8: Aug 13-17

This camp will cover the basics of dribbling, passing, and shooting in game-like situations while teaching campers the rules of Basketball and specific strategies. Instruction will focus on building fundamental skills and team play. Emphasis will be on teamwork and sportsmanship in a fun, sports environment.

Soccer Camp

Week 3: July 9-13

Week 7: Aug 6-10

Playing both indoors and outdoors, campers will develop their passing, shooting, goalkeeping and dribbling skills. Each day will include competitive scrimmages and fun drills where campers will learn the rules and strategies of the sport.

FREE Lunch & Afternoon Snack

Campers attending Camp Connolly, TEAM Connolly Sports Camps, and Teen Leadership Camp are served a nutritious lunch and an afternoon snack daily. Lunch and snack are provided Massachusetts Department of Education Summer Food Program at no cost to families. Participation in this program is optional. Menus are available at the camp office.

Financial Assistance

Cost should never be a barrier to a child's chance to learn, thrive, and grow in a safe and supportive summer camp environment. Our annual Reach Out campaign allows us to offer financial assistance through our ACCESS program. We offer reduced rates to individuals and families who cannot afford the full price of membership or programs. Eligibility is based on income level, family size and funds available. We also accept vouchers and have EEC slots for children K2 – age 12. Please contact the Welcome Center for more information.

EARLY BIRD SPECIALS AND SIBLING DISCOUNTS

Register by March 31 and receive 50% off extended day care. Siblings always receive a 10% discount.

Registration Information

Camp Fees: A \$25 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit is due at the time of registration for each session. The balance is due 14 days prior to the start of the camp session, or the deposit and registration for that session of camp will be forfeited. Four weeks cancellation notice must be given or 50% of the session fee will be charged.

Family Member & Youth Member Rates: To receive the family member rate for camps, a child's family membership must be active or purchased at the time of registration. To receive the youth member rate, a child must possess or purchase a year-long youth membership. Family or youth memberships must be active during the weeks a child is enrolled in camp in order to receive family or youth member rates.

Failure to pick-up by 5:00pm (regular hours) or 6:00pm (post-camp hours) will result in a late payment fee of \$1.00 per minute per child. Please note that pre- and post-camp times are not part of the traditional camp day schedule. This is a safe and supervised, free-choice time for campers.
