## About Camp Wakanda

Camp Wakanda is the Burbank YMCA's beautiful off-site day camp located on Stiles Pond in Boxford. Camp Wakanda is built on 50 years of day camp tradition and excellence. At Camp Wakanda campers have a variety of activities to choose from like swimming, boating, archery, crafts, sports, challenge courses, drama, nature trails, fishing, and new in 2010 horseback riding (additional fee required). ## About Camp Wakanda CIT

Camp Wakanda's Counselor-In-Training (CIT) Program is a one-week leadership and job skills program for adolescents entering ninth and tenth grade. CIT's are trained in first aid, CPR, water safety and behavior management. CIT's receive individualized mentoring from experienced staff members and are actively engaged in program planning and curriculum development. CIT's will also get a chance to exercise their creativity in planning theme weeks and other special events. Camp Wakanda CIT is certified by the American Camping Association (ACA).

## Application Process

Admission to Camp Wakanda's CIT program is highly competitive. Self-motivated, mature teens with an interest in child care or camp that will be positive role models to our campers are encouraged to apply. In order to be a part of this unique opportunity teens will need to complete an application and an interview with a member of the camp management staff. Space is limited for each session.
