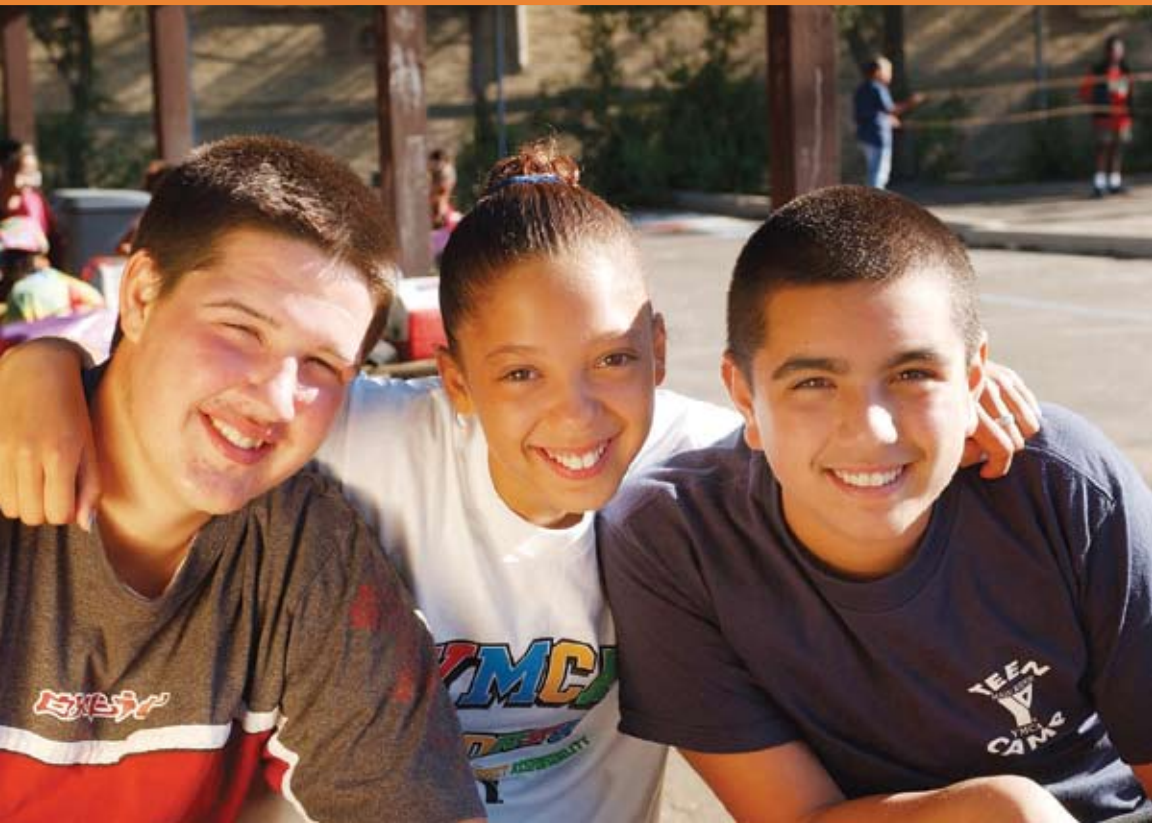

Refunds and Transfers:

While we understand that summer plans may change, you should make yourself aware of our refund policy. The following are guidelines for refunds and transfers.

- One-time \$15 registration fee is non-refundable
- Camp Session Deposits are non-refundable
- Request for transfers must be submitted in writing one week prior to the start of the session
- A \$5 processing fee will be assessed for all changes

For Your Information

Massachusetts State Law requires all campers to have a completed health form on file with the camp office prior to attending day camp. This form requires all immunization dates and a physical exam with physician's signature prior to attending day camp.

A photo I.D. is required to pick up a child from camp-no exceptions. Changes to the pick up list must be given to the director in writing by authorized person.
